These are a few of the stories in this remarkable retelling of some of the world's great adventures. Adventures where men and women have survived in spite of facing certain tragedy or even death.

From the title, *Tales of Heroes and Angels*, one might expect these stories of survival and great accomplishment to be filled with many references to the Almighty, God, and supernatural beings, but there are none. Most of these stories are related as fact and are historically proven. It is left to the reader to explain the incidents that the authors cannot.

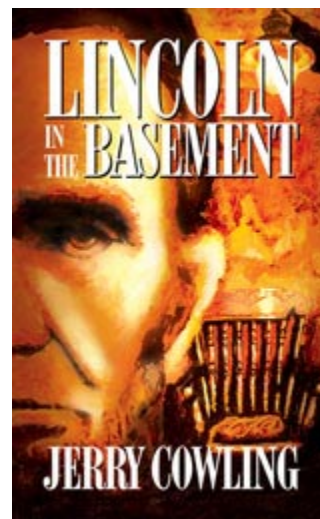

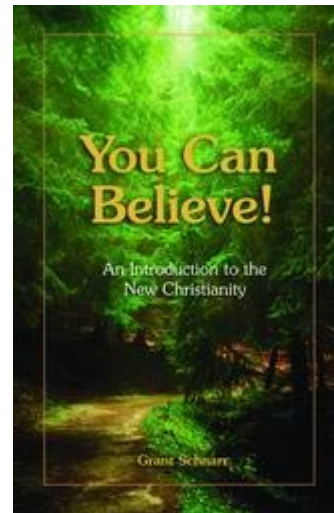

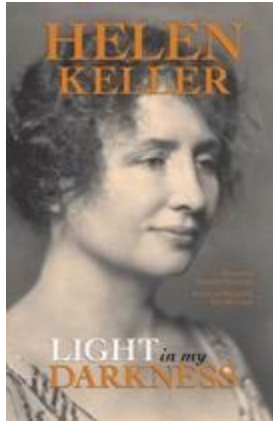

These accomplishments took place at a time when few women attended college and the disabled were often dismissed from normal society. Nevertheless, she wrote seven books and numerous articles, devoted time and energy to social reform, and lectured on behalf of the disabled. She also helped initiate foundations that improve the lives of the deaf and blind around the world.

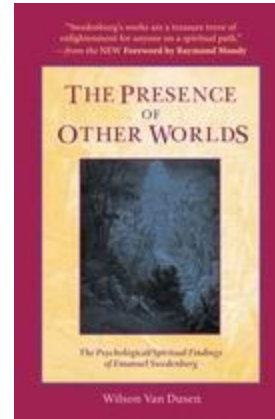

The Forgotten Masterpiece of Victor Hugo

If you're not one of the 25 million people worldwide who've read Dan Brown's novel *The Da Vinci Code*, you have four months to get caught up before the movie opens on May 19, 2006. Directed by Ron Howard and starring some of the world's best actors—Tom Hanks; France's Audrey Tautou (*The Very Long Engagement*); the U.K.'s Ian McKellen (*Lord of the Rings*)—the film version of *The Da Vinci Code* is bound to be a smash hit. It's also sure to further upset Catholics and fundamentalist Christians already enraged by the book's central premise (which Brown claims is fact) that Jesus was married to Mary Magdalene and fathered a daughter whose bloodline has survived into present-day Europe.

The movie will also provoke a new avalanche of interest in the alleged Paris-based Priory of Sion, which, according to the novel (Brown also says this is fact), is a secret society that for 1,000 years has protected the secret of Jesus's bloodline and his descendants themselves. The title of the book derives from the fact (again historically true, according to Brown) that Leonardo da Vinci was one of 26 "grandmasters" of the Priory of Sion.

The Da Vinci Code alludes briefly to the supposed grandmastership of the Priory of Sion of *Les Misérables* author Victor Hugo. Ron Howard's movie version will make readers and movie-goers everywhere eager to know more about this alleged connection, rumors of which derive from Hugo's involvement with "table-tapping" seances in 1853-1855 while in exile on the Channel island of Jersey: Transcripts exist of the poet's conversations with 115 "discarnate spirits" including the illustrious dead (Shakespeare, Galileo, etc.), legendary animals (e.g. Balaam's Ass, the Lion of Androcles), entities who said they'd never been alive ("The Shadow of the Sepulcher," "Death," and others), a string of abstract concepts (such as 'India,' 'Metempsychosis,' 'Ocean') and even extraterrestrials from the planet Mercury who channeled drawings of themselves.

Conversations with Eternity: The Forgotten Masterpiece of Victor Hugo is a translation (the first in English), with lengthy commentary, of the transcripts of the more riveting of these seances. A completely revised edition, due out July 2006, provides new transcripts (including the text of a new, "channeled" play by Shakespeare) while abbreviating and reexamining the old. It demonstrates that the cosmology of the spirits derived in part from the cabbalic *Zohar*, which Hugo studied intently in his 40s. It shows that Hugo was a student of Hinduism and that, through the poet Lamartine, he was greatly influenced by the seeming pantheism of Goethe. It raises the question, why is the presence of Giordano Bruno so palpable at the seances? It asks whether the Priory of Sion—or some other, vaster, secret society—indeed lurked behind the Jersey island communings with the dead.

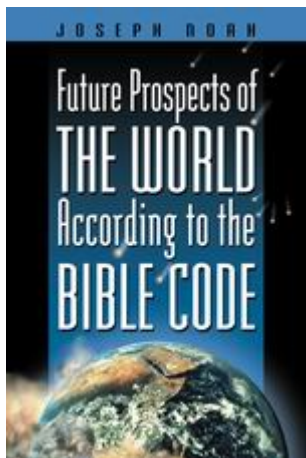

President Bush described it as the beginning of a long struggle between good and evil. He was right. According to the Bible Code, it was the start of a ten-and-a-half-year countdown, the time and half time as prophesied in Daniel 12 of the Old Testament and also described in the last book of the New Testament, *The Revelation to John*."

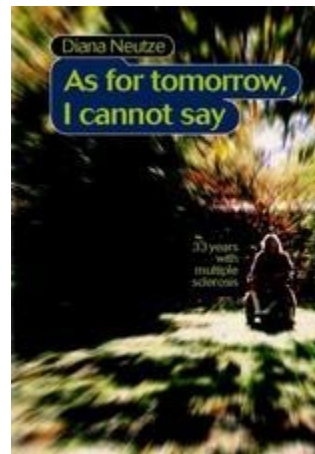

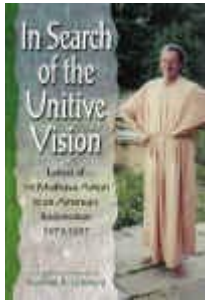

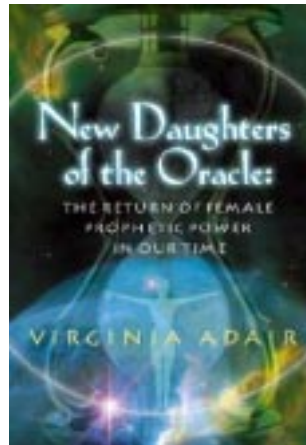
